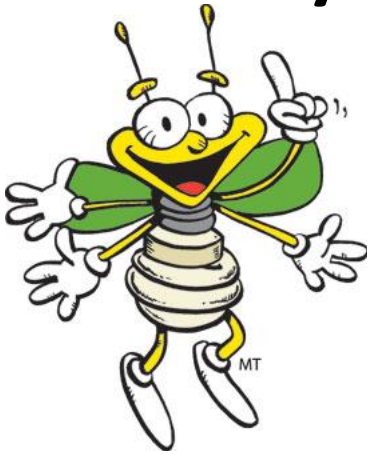
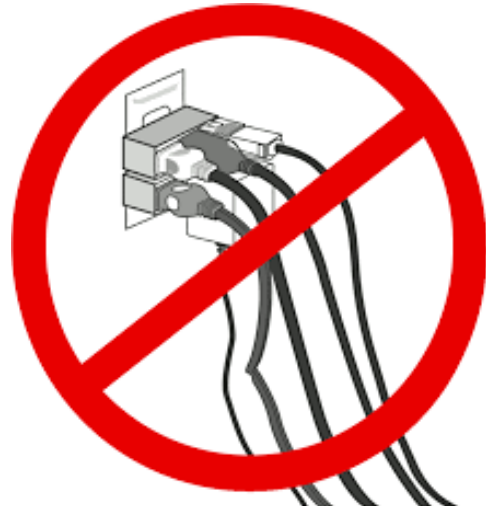


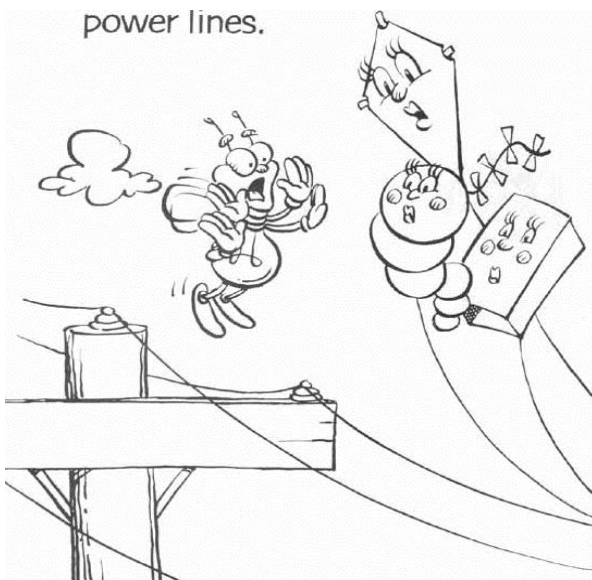

Balloons and kite strings connect you to dangerous electric current. Never fly kites near power lines, never touch overhead power lines with your body or any other objects.

An electric substation is a place where transformers lower electricity's voltage before it is sent over wires to our homes. Substations contain dangerous electrical equipment.

**KEEP OUT!**





Never play near  
or in trees that  
are close to  
power lines.

- Never operate electrical appliances near water
- Fly kites away from power lines
- Never climb utility poles or towers
- Electric outlets are ONLY for plugs
- Stay away from substations and transformers
- Call the power company BEFORE you dig
- Keep ladders away from power lines
- Never climb trees near power lines
- Replace damaged electrical cords
- Stay away from downed power lines. Call for help!!
- Do not overload electrical outlets with too many plugs
- Keep antennas away from power lines
- Never pull a plug by the cord
