### **EAR CORN**

Exhibit shall consist of 10 ears

#### **Classes:**

- \_\_\_ 7. Corn, best ear
- \_\_\_ 8. Popcorn
- \_\_\_ 9. Corn, Sweet
- \_\_\_ 10. Corn, any other unusual variety, identified

### **SUGAR BEETS**

Beet should be topped by trimming at the crown just below the leaf petiole but not too far into the root.  
Beet should be clean and free from soil.

#### **Classes:**

- \_\_\_ 11. 6 beets
- \_\_\_ 12. Best shaped beet
- \_\_\_ 13. Largest beet

### **SHEAVES & VINES**

#### **Classes:**

- \_\_\_ 14. Any named variety small grain – 3 inches
- \_\_\_ 15. Any named variety grass – 3 inches
- \_\_\_ 16. Beans, green snap– with stem (12)
- \_\_\_ 17. Beets, table – (5)
- \_\_\_ 18. Broccoli – (1 head)

- \_\_\_ 19. Cabbage – DO NOT WASH Cut stem 1/4" below first leaf. Remove all but 1–3 wrapper leaves (1 head)
- \_\_\_ 20. Carrots – 1/2" stem, leave root tip, clean (5)
- \_\_\_ 21. Cauliflower – (1 head)
- \_\_\_ 22. Corn, sweet – husks on (5 ears)
- \_\_\_ 23. Cucumbers, pickling – approximately 1-1/4" diameter, 3-1/2" long (3)
- \_\_\_ 24. Cucumbers, slicing – approximately 2-1/2" diameter, 6–9" long (2)
- \_\_\_ 26. Eggplant – with stem (2)
- \_\_\_ 27. Muskmelon/cantaloupe – no stem (1)
- \_\_\_ 28. Onions, yellow – tops 1", do not peel, cut roots to 1/4" (3)
- \_\_\_ 29. Onions, white – tops 1", do not peel, cut roots to 1/4" (3)
- \_\_\_ 30. Onions, red – tops 1", do not peel, cut roots to 1/4" (3)
- \_\_\_ 31. Peppers, bell – 1" stem (2)
- \_\_\_ 32. Peppers, chili – any variety, 1/2" stem (3)
- \_\_\_ 33. Potatoes—any variety
- \_\_\_ 34. Pumpkin – with stem
- \_\_\_ 35. Squash, summer – yellow or other summer squash of same type, with stem, brush clean (2)
- \_\_\_ 37. Squash, summer – zucchini, 1/4"- 1/2" stem, brush clean (2)
- \_\_\_ 39. Squash, winter – same type, with stems (2)
- \_\_\_ 40. Peas with stem (12 pods)
- \_\_\_ 41. Tomatoes, green – stems removed (5)
- \_\_\_ 42. Pear tomatoes, ripe no stem (5)
- \_\_\_ 43. Tomatoes, ripe – stems removed (5)
- \_\_\_ 44. Turnips – leave taproot, trim tops to 1"(5)
- \_\_\_ 47. Watermelon – with stem (1)
- \_\_\_ 49. Other garden crop – identified (3 entries of same vegetable required for a new class)
