HERB DIVISION: Identify variety

- ___ 12. Basil, 3 stems (6-10" stems with branches included)
- ___ 13. Dill, 3 heads (4" stems and 4" heads)
- ___ 14. Italian Parsley 3 sprigs (4" stems)
- ___ 15. Parsley, 3 sprigs (4" stems)
- ___ 16. Chives, 12 spears, full length
- ___ 17. Mint, unidentified, 3 stems (12" stems with branches included)
- ___ 18. Oregano, 3 stems (3" stems with branches)
- ___ 19. Sage, 3 stems (3-6" stems with branches included)
- ___ 20. Garlic, 3 bulbs
- ___ 21. Miscellaneous Spices and Herbs, 3 stems, identify variety

FRUITS DIVISION:

- ___ 22. Berries, ½ pint (1 cup) of any same variety, identified
- ___ 23. Grapes, any variety
- ___ 24. Watermelon – 1
- ___ 25. Melon, any type other than watermelon, identified (cantaloupe, honeydew, etc.) – 1
- ___ 26. Tree ripened fruit, 5 of any same variety, identified

VEGETABLE DIVISION:

- ___ 27. Beans, snap, any same variety, identified (stems attached) – 12
- ___ 28. Beets, table, clean, 1/2" tops – 5
- ___ 29. Broccoli – 1 head
- ___ 30. Brussels sprouts – 6
- ___ 31. Cabbage – 1 head (DO NOT WASH) Cut stem 1/4" below first leaf. Remove all but 1–3 wrapper leaves
- ___ 32. Carrots, clean, 1/2" tops – 5
- ___ 33. Cauliflower – 1 head
- ___ 34. Cucumbers, pickling dill style under 4" (clean but not washed, stems evenly cut) – 3
- ___ 35. Cucumbers, pickling sweet style 2 - 2 1/2" long (clean but not washed, stems evenly cut) – 10
- ___ 36. Cucumbers, slicing - (clean but not washed, stems evenly cut) – 2
- ___ 37. Eggplant, stems on – 2
- ___ 38. Leafy vegetable, any type lettuce, spinach, or greens – 10 leaves
- ___ 40. Onions, White, identified, 1" tops, do not peel, cut roots to 1/4" – 3
- ___ 41. Onions, Yellow, identified, 1" tops, do not peel, cut roots to 1/4" – 3
- ___ 42. Onions, Red, identified, 1" tops, do not peel, cut roots to 1/4" – 3
- ___ 43. Onions, green bunching, not bulbed, washed, trim roots and tops to an even length, cut roots to 1/4" – 12
- ___ 44. Peas, pods – 12

- ___ 45. Peppers, sweet bell, green or ripe (1" stem, cut) – 2
- ___ 46. Peppers, any other sweet variety, identified (1/2" stem, cut) – 5 (Italian sweet pepper, pimento, cherry, etc.)
- ___ 48. Peppers, warm chili, any variety, identify (1/2 " stem, cut) – 5 (Anaheim, ancho, pablano, etc.)
- ___ 49. Peppers, jalapeno (1/2" stem, cut) – 5
- ___ 50. Peppers, any other hot chili variety, identified (1/2" stem, cut) – 5 (Hot cherry, Serrano, cayenne, tabasco, habanero, Hungarian yellow, etc.)
- ___ 53. Potatoes, clean – 5
- ___ 56. Pumpkin, any variety – 1
- ___ 58. Radishes – bunch of 10
- ___ 59. Rhubarb, 1" leaves left on stalk, base stem attached, pull stalk – 6 stalks
- ___ 60. Squash (summer) picked small before seeds toughen
- ___ 61. Zucchini squash, 8" or less (cut stem) – 3
- ___ 62. Any other type summer squash, same variety, identified, cut stem – 3 *Squash, winter mature (mature skins are difficult to puncture with fingernail)*

- ___ 65. Any winter squash, same variety, cut stem – 2
- ___ 67. Tomatoes, green, stems off – 5
- ___ 68. Tomatoes, ripe, stems off – 5
- ___ 69. Tomatoes, Roma or similar processing type, stems off – 5
- ___ 70. Tomatoes, small cherry type, stems on – 10
- ___ 71. Turnips, clean, 1/2" tops – 5
- ___ 72. Any other vegetable, identify variety, see guidebook for number to show.
- ___ 73. Garden Sweet Corn, 3 ears

Novelties - No points or premiums awarded

- ___ 76. Giant zucchini
- ___ 77. Most unusually shaped vegetable or fruit (any variety)
- ___ 78. "All dressed up"- Vegetables can be painted, decorated or carved, and other parts of vegetables can be used to decorate.
- ___ 79. ADULT/YOUTH VEGETABLE BASKET— Basket or tray containing 5 vegetables and/or fruits and/or herbs (quantities as listed in classes). To be grown and entered by an adult/youth team. No points awarded.
