___ 134. Dahlia—dwarf, 1 bloom -less than 4" diameter
___ 135. Dahlia – medium decorative, 3 blooms 4"- 6" diameter
___ 136. Dahlia—medium decorative, 1 bloom - 4"-6" diameter
___ 137. Dahlia – large decorative, 1 bloom - 6"- 10" diameter
___ 138. Dahlia – giant, 1 bloom - larger than 10" diameter
___ 139. Gladiola – solid color, 1 spike
___ 145. Hibiscus – 1 bloom— in exhibitor's container
___ 146. Rose – hybrid tea, 1 bloom with foliage

- ___ 148. Rose – floribunda or grandiflora, 1 spray with foliage
- ___ 150. Rose – miniature, 1 spray with foliage
- ___ 152. Any other bloom (without a class) – perennial, identify variety

- ___ 178. Mini Bouquet – arrangement of exhibitor grown miniature flowers less than 5”
