CLUB BOOK RESULTS

During the Morgan County Fair, on Wednesday the 24th, 4-H Clubs had the opportunity to turn in their club books from the year for judging. This includes their Secretary Book, Treasurers Book, Community Pride Book, and Scrapbook. These books are the records that are kept by their respective elected officers for the 4-H Year. The 4-H Year runs October 1 – September 30.

In the Secretary Book Contest, Weldon Valley 4-H Club placed 1st, Lads ‘N’ Lassies 4-H Club, 2nd, Winning Edge 4-H Club, 3rd, Morgan Sandburs 4-H Club, 4th, and Cowpokes and Cactus 4-H Club, 5th. The Champion Secretary Record Book award is sponsored by FMS Bank.

The Treasurer Book Contest had four entries. Placing 1st is Weldon Valley 4-H Club; Winning Edge 4-H Club, 2nd; Lads ‘N’ Lassies 4-H Club, 3rd; and Cowpokes and Cactus 4-H Club, 4th. The Champion Treasure Book award is also sponsored by FMS Bank.

The clubs that exhibited scrapbooks at the 2024 Morgan County Fair were Lads ‘N’ Lassies 4-H Club, Snyder Pioneers 4-H Club, Winning Edge 4-H Club, Weldon Valley 4-H Club, Wiggins Cornerstone, and Wildcat 4-H Club. This year Lads ‘N’ Lassies 4-H Club received Champion and Weldon Valley 4-H Club, Reserve Champion. The Champion and Reserve Champion Club Scrapbook receive awards sponsored by Leader’s Advisory Committee.

Our final area that clubs can enter is Community Pride. Each club completes a minimum of one community service project each year, and the Community Pride contest allows the clubs to develop a book showcasing their community service. This year’s winner of the Community Pride award, which is sponsored by KSIR Radio, is the Lads ‘N’ Lassies 4-H Club. With Weldon Valley coming in 2nd.

All of these books are on display in the Mark Arndt Event Center at the Morgan County Fair Grounds for the remainder of the 2024 Morgan County Fair which is held July 24-August 1.
