4-H SHOTGUN SHOOT, FIRST PRE-COUNTY FAIR EVENT

The Morgan County Fair 4-H Shooting Sports Contests kicked off this weekend with 5-Stand being held on Saturday, June 28 and Trap and Skeet on Sunday, June 29. Eight youth competed on Saturday and 21 youth participated in the contests on Sunday.

In the 5-Stand Contest, Gunnar Yocam placed first in the Junior Division, and Axel Lorenzini placed 2nd. Odin Nilsen was first in the Senior Division, Soul Keller 2nd; Wyatt Chacon, 3rd; Rylan Schreiner, 4th; Layne Steinman, 5th; and Saxson Keller, 6th.

The Trap Contest on Sunday, June 29th brought some extra excitement with a tie-breaker shoot-off in the Junior division and a three round shoot-off for the seniors! Gunnar Yocam placed first in the Junior Division. Axel Lorenzini came in 2nd; Kaine Eicher 3rd; Tucker Martens, 4th; and Wyatt Johnson, 5th. Other participants were Jack Binnendyk, Bentley Larrick, Gavyn Larrick, Raylan Neal, and Cora Paris. Placings in the senior division were Layne Steinman, 1st; Damon Lucero, 2nd; Odin Nilsen, 3rd; Saxson Keller, 4th; and Wyatt Chacon, 5th. The other youth competing in the senior division were Caden Cozad, Soul Keller, Tate Strand and Eli Williams.

Rounding out the weekend was the Skeet Contest. Top award in the junior division went to Gunnar Yocam who shot 46 out of 50 possible points. Second place went to Axel Lorenzini, Bentley Larrick, 3rd; and Raylan Neal, 4th. Odin Nilsen took first place in the Senior Division with a 45 out of 50. Second Place went to Layne Steinman; Soul Keller, 3rd; Rylan Schriener, 4th; Wyatt Chacon, 5th and Saxson Keller, 6th.

The top five in the all three of the Shotgun Contests for both the junior and senior age divisions will represent Morgan County 4-H at the Colorado 4-H State Shooting Sports Championship in Colorado Springs over Labor Day Weekend.

Superintendent for the 4-H Shotgun Shoot was Paul Oliveira. Oliveira was assisted by Dale Chacon, Levi Dixon, Andy Larrick, and Jay Marshall.

The next 4-H Shooting Sports contest will be Friday, July 11 at 5 pm where youth will compete in muzzleloading. On Saturday, July 12, the .22 Rifle and .22 Pistol contests will be held, and the events will wrap up Sunday, July 13, with Air Pistol, Air Rifle, and Archery Contests.

Shooting sports awards will be presented at an awards potluck on Tuesday, July 15 at 6 p.m.
The event will be held at the Mark Arndt Event Center at the Morgan County Fairgrounds.
